ESW staff receive occasional requests to host and provide mentorship for postdoctoral fellows who make external applications to diverse international funders; in these cases, the fellow is directly salaried by the funder (not via Sussex) and the funding application is outside our existing

1. Bench Fees

- f If the fellow is not salaried via Sussex, the School will charge bench fees for the duration of the fellowship currently £1000 per term (or £350 per month) up to £3000 per year in line with existing policy on Visiting Fellows.
- f If it is not possible for the prospective fellow to include bench fees in the fellowship application, the host (mentor) can seek approval in advance of the fellowship application being submitted to:
 - f use their devolved (PA Account) funds to cover bench fees (subject to agreement of HOS);
 - f draw on Research Centre budget to cover bench fees (subject to agreement from Centre Director and DRAKE in addition to HOS); or
 - f make a written request to HOS to waive or reduce bench fees if sufficient case can be made for the value of the fellow's contribution to the School (subject to agreement of HOS and DRAKE).
